



HOMOEOPATHIC ASSOCIATION OF SOUTH AFRICA

FEES, ELIGIBILITY FOR AND CATEGORIES OF MEMBERSHIP

Membership of the Association

In accordance with the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, the National Health Act and the Constitution of the HSA, any person registered with the Allied Health Professions Council of South Africa as a Homoeopathic Practitioner, Homoeopathic Intern or as a Homoeopathic Student will receive membership of the Association upon receipt of the application form and relevant payment of membership fees.

Categories of Membership

Full Membership (par. 5.1.1 of the HSA Constitution)

Any person registered as a Homoeopathic Practitioner or Homoeopathic Intern with the Allied Health Professions Council of South Africa may become a Full Member of the Association.

1) **Full Membership (Practitioner) Fee 2010 R990-00**

a) Practitioner (Grade 1) R 495 – a practitioner in their first year* of registration as a homoeopathic practitioner after completing the M.Tech programme (50% Discount)

b) Practitioner (Grade 2) R 792 – a practitioner in their second year* of registration as a homoeopathic practitioner after completing the M.Tech programme (20% Discount)

**Proof of date of registration required together with the application for membership*

c) National Board Member R 792 – any participating member of the HSA National Board is entitled to a 20% discount in membership fee, excluding students and academic staff.

2) **Retired¹, 70 and older², UJ & DUT Fulltime Academic Staff³, Intern, Fulltime student⁴ Membership Fee 2010 R 495-00 (50% Discount)**

1. Note that this is relevant only to complete retirement and does not provide for semi-retirement.

2. Qualifying age for 50% discount is 70 years.

3. Only relevant for fulltime academic staff members of either institution

4. Qualified practitioners who are fulltime students receive a 50% discount. Please be sure to provide proof of registration as a fulltime student together with membership application / renewal.

3) **Life Member & Honorary Member** (par. 5.1.3 of the HSA Constitution = Free membership)

Student member (par. 5.1.2 of the HSA Constitution)

Any person registered as a Full-time Homoeopathic Student or Student Intern with the Allied Health Professions Council of South Africa may become a Student Member of the Association. Student Members enjoy all the rights and privileges as stipulated in the Constitution and at a reduced membership fee.

Student Membership Fee 2010 **R100-00** (Rate has remained unchanged)

Life membership (par. 5.1.3 of the HSA Constitution)

Members who have been Full Members of the Association for at least 25 (twenty five) years in aggregate, shall automatically become Life Members. The Association's National Board may, if justifiable, at its discretion grant Life Membership to a Member who does not meet this requirement. Life Members enjoy all the rights and privileges of Full Membership.

Membership Fee **R0-00 (Free)**

Honorary Membership (par. 5.1.4 of the HSA Constitution)

The National Board may elect prominent scientists and other persons residing within or outside the Republic, as Honorary Members if they have in the opinion of the Board made valuable contributions to the advancement of Homoeopathic science or to the welfare and benefit of the Association.

Membership Fee **R0-00 (Free)**

Subscription Service

A subscription service is now available to any member of the public with a special interest in Homoeopathy. This membership fee must be renewed annually and will provide all information of public interest to such a member including the regular official newsletter of the HSA and any media releases. This service does not entitle the holder to any rights or privileges afforded to a full member of the association in terms of the HSA Constitution.

Subscription Fee 2010 **R 300-00**
