Dr Neil Gower completed his Masters Degree in Homoeopathy at the University of Johannesburg in 2004. He then completed a Certificate in Project Management (*cum laude*) through the University of Johannesburg and is currently studying his Certificate of Medicine and Law (CML) at UNISA/University of Pretoria.

Significant Achievements

Dr Neil Gower completed a research study in part fulfilment of his master's degree on The Effect of Maltineem® (*Azadirachta indica* leaf extract) on Psoriasis. He has been involved in numerous projects including the development of Homoeopathic NHRPL Schedule 2006 and 2007, commented on Proposed Amendments to the Allied Health Professions Act, and given extensive comment to proposed regulation of medicines, devices & structure of MCC. He gave extensive comment to the proposed "Minimum Professional Requirements for Allied Health Professionals" and contributed to the development of methodology for Pricing / Costing of Non-proprietary Homoeopathic medicines. He authored "Homoeopathy In South Africa" – a paper authored to discuss homoeopathy's current position and future ambitions. He expanded on this document including amongst other items: the integration of homoeopathy into the public healthcare system, medicines control and the possible future of CAM professions generally and has been involved in the organisation and success of all the HSA Congress's to date.

Current Activities

Dr Neil Gower is the current National Secretary to the Homoeopathic Association of South Africa (HSA). He is an Educational Advisory Committee Member of The Homoeopathy Department of the University of Johannesburg as well as a full time lecturer for the Department of Homoeopathy.
