### Personal Info

In 1996 David was responsible for setting up a Medical Malpractice facility in South Africa on behalf of Glenrand MIB Limited, a facility which exists to this day. During his 16 year tenure at Glenrand MIB David was the broker charged with handling the insurance portfolio for one of the big three hospital groups and the Liability Insurance program for the Medical and Dental Associations of South Africa, The South African Society of Physiotherapy and the Optometric Association. David has worked in Professional Indemnity and other Liability Insurance classes for more than 40 years dealing with both underwriting and claims issues and has been a regular guest speaker for a number of Professional Associations

### Significant Achievements

David has specialized in Medical Malpractice Insurance since the mid 1980's and in 1988 was responsible for creating the first viable commercial Medical Malpractice Insurance scheme providing practitioners with an alternative indemnity insurance option. Innovations that were introduced included differential risk rating between different classes of professional and the ability to finance premiums on a monthly basis, ideas which were subsequently used by the defence organizations then operating in South Africa.

### Current Activities

David is the Managing Director and a shareholder of General and Professional Liability Acceptances (Pty) Ltd, an underwriting agency predominantly owned by certain syndicates at Lloyd's and for whom they transact Medical Malpractice Insurance for registered medical practitioners, allied healthcare practitioners, hospitals and clinics. Marketform Limited, the syndicate group that is the major shareholder in GPLA and for whom GPLA underwrites business, is the largest provider of non-American Medical Malpractice Insurance in the United Kingdom and transacts Medical Malpractice business in more than 30 countries.
