Dr Bernard Brom qualified from UCT medical school in 1965 and started an Integrative medical practice in 1978. He completed a diploma in Acupuncture (Singapore) and in Homeopathy CEDH (France).

### Significant Achievements

Dr Bernard Brom is the founder of SASIM (South African Society of Integrative Medicine). He started the first South African journal of natural medicine called Complementary Medicine in 1996 which subsequently became the South African Journal of Natural Medicine. He served on the Complementary Medicine Committee for two years (a branch of the MCC). He compiled numerous articles and seminars supporting the practice of Complementary and Integrative medicine.

### Current Activities

Dr Bernard Brom is the present Co-Chairman of the South African Society of Integrative Medicine (SASIM). He holds a special interest in the Science and Art of Medicine. Dr Brom has also been the Chairman of South African Acupuncture Medical Association (SAAMA) for 5 years.
